PUBLIC COMMENTS

Steve Joosten asked about the long range plan Mike Nelson may have for a campground located on the Rustic property he had purchased. Alvin stated there has not been any discussion on this. Molly Joosten asked about the two eight foot easement boat landings that are for the people in the back lots at Rustics. Molly asked if we need any pine needles for the trail on Gibson Island.

Bonnie Olson talked about the Citizens Academy course she had recently taken. She said was it was a very interesting 8 week course that covered many topics including the Shawano dive team, police dogs, and the shooting range. This course was coordinated with the police and sheriffs department. She would recommend this course to everyone.

CLERKS REPORT

The Clerk read the minutes from the March 12, 2018 meeting. Dennis Thornton made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Harold Polzin, three in favor non opposed, motion carried.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin talked about using salt brine on the roads to prevent freezing and ice; this is a much better option than salting the roads. We must try to do a better job to avoid having so much salt run into the lakes.

Election workers wages was discussed, Harold Polzin made a motion to approve raising the wages for the election wages to \$12.00 across the board, Dennis second, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried

Alvin stated the paperwork for the Compost site is all in order. The Compost site will be opening on April 28th. Recycling Center hours will be just on Saturdays during the summer, there will be no Wednesdays.

Alvin mentioned we need to hire someone to help get our Comprehensive plan completed.

The board went over a proposed Financial Report that will be approved at the Annual Meeting which will be held on April 17, 2018.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Dennis Thornton talked about the DNR grant the town has been approved for; he stated the total amount approved for Belle Plaine is \$36,593.75 which will be over a three year period. The newsletter will be coming out soon.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Kay Kristof gave the Treasurer's report. A motion was made by Harold Polzin to accept the bills as presented. Seconded by Dennis Thornton, all three in favor, none opposed, motion carried. Board of Review is scheduled for Wednesday May 16, 2018 6-8 pm. Open book is scheduled for April 22, 2018 1:30 to 3:30pm.
