PUBLIC COMMENTS:

A question was asked concerning the land that will coming up for sale on Grass Lake road, if you purchase a lot can this then be subdivided. Alvin stated that it could be sold down to one acre lots however there must be 100 feet of the lot on a public road.

CLERKS REPORT

Kris Vomastic Clerk read the minutes from the March 11, 2019 meeting. Dennis Thornton made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Harold Polzin, all in favor none opposed, motion carried.

AGENDA

Operator license for Alyssa Boivin was gone over, a motion was made by Dennis Thornton to approve the license, seconded by Harold Polzin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

ATC RIGHT OF WAY TO CUT BRUSH

A discussion was held prior to signing the paperwork for the ATC to have the right of way to cut an additional five foot along the road way. The ATC will be compensating the town for this right \$4000.00

DESIGNATE TOWN NEWSPAPER

Alvin stated that we will need to set a date to check the roads, we will be doing about 1 ½ miles this summer.

FIRE ORDINANCE

Dennis Thornton made a motion to approve our new fire ordinance and to discuss this at the Annual meeting, seconded by Harold Polzin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin stated he has received calls concerning the weight limits.

Alvin and Dick Hesse went to look at the Michael Sleeper property; they have a problem with water running into their garage when the snow melts. The way the property runs down to the river, proper landscaping could have helped. They noted on how the new high schools design had helped with the water shed.

WAGNER LAKE ROAD

The town has been trying to work with Rose McKowiak who lives at W9570 Lake Wagner Road in trying to get a turn around on her property for the large trucks that go down this road for snow plowing or to pick up garbage; another option could be to work with Donny Buettner who said he would be willing to work with the town by using some of his property instead.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Dennis stated that the newsletter is now finished. He had included in the newsletter the information about the water testing that will be done Memorial Day week end and the land auction located near Long Lake.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Kay Kristof gave the Treasurer's report. A motion was made by Harold Polzin to accept the report as presented. Seconded by Dennis Thornton, all three in favor, none opposed, motion carried.
