Dennis Thornton presented the letter that had been received from the Clintonville Area Foundation for our invasive project on Gibson Island, with a check for \$1,720. He stated \$26,000 was spent on Cloverleaf Lakes milfoil control and we will be getting \$19,000 back from the DNR grant.
