PUBLIC COMMENTS

Andrew Hines who bought the Green's property by Gibson Island picked up a copy of the Ingres and Egress easement agreement in December. The town is hoping to get this agreement with him completed soon. Dennis Thornton will follow up with him.

Ben Warren asked if there is an update on the disk golf project. Alvin stated nothing is being done and is assuming the request has been dropped.

Jake Mc Kay asked the board for approval to legally drive his Kaboda UTV on the road from one of his property's to the other. It is about a half of a mile. The town does not want to post our roads to allow UTV's the right to drive on them. Alvin stated around the lakes there is too much traffic and that if a 12 year old has taken the safety course it would allow them the right to drive on the road. There is too much potential for a bad accident and the town would liable.

Dick Hesse stated the weight limits will be going on the roads next Wednesday.

Ben Warren asked about salt on Cloverleaf Lake road. Dennis Thornton said putting less salt on this road is due to the run off going into the lakes.

CLERKS REPORT

The Clerk read the minutes from the February 12, 2018 meeting. Dennis Thornton made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Harold Polzin, three in favor none opposed, motion carried. The Clerk also showed the board a copy of area election workers' wages. After some discussion it was decided this should be put on the April agenda to discuss further.

CHAIRMAN' REPORT

Monday March 26 at 6:00 pm will be the yearly audit for 2017 books.

Alvin talked about the downside in the dairy industry and how it even affects our town. We have lost several dairies just since the first of the year.

Alvin talked to Kay about some of the problems with the taxes this year. He mentioned this needs to be straightened out as soon as possible because it reflects on all of the board members.

The Cloverleaf Lakes Sanitary District paid for the new UTV that had been purchased for the fire department. The minutes from last month need to reflect that the town did not pay for it and we are very grateful for their generous donation.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Dennis Thornton mentioned that Molly Joosten asked if another coat of stain could be put on the boardwalk at Gibson Island this summer.

Dennis also mentioned that they are looking for a boat monitor for this summer. It would be about thirty hours a week and is mostly weekends and holidays and they would need computer experience. Age was discussed and will be checked into.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Kay Kristof gave the Treasurer's report. A motion was made by Harold Polzin to accept the bills as presented. Seconded by Dennis Thornton, all three in favor, none opposed, motion carried.
