Alvin stated that equalized values should be good because they have gone down. He then opened it up to public comments.

Public Comments:

Corey Retzlaff talked about drive ways and roads that need to be trimmed to allow emergency vehicles to get in. Corey a volunteer EMT and his brother Mark who is a volunteer fire fighter, will put together a list of driveways that need attention and the Clerk will send a letter to the people who own the driveways.

Alvin said on that note he had talked to the Shawano County Health department and they will be contacting the state concerning the conditions at the Cloverleaf Trailer Park.

Clerk's Report:

The Clerk read the minutes from the August 12 board meeting. Dennis Thornton made a motion to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Harold Polzin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Chairman's Report:

Alvin Bartz stated that our building project has been started and we are ready to pour the concrete. We will need to meet with the electric/gas company. We will be purchasing a generator for the new building.

Alvin stated that Matt Mroszek who does brush treatment for the town has a brush head on a machine and will help the town with cleanup of trees.

Alvin talked about how the fair went this year. He said the Fire mans stand will need some updates. He also stated that \$32,000 was taken in this year.

Supervisor's Report:

Dennis mentioned that the newsletter is ready to go out, we will see how the people respond to the survey in the letter on ATV and UTV traffic on the town's roads.

Dennis gave an update on the Gibson Island planting, he stated that Joy Krubsack and her volunteers are ready to start. There will be some expenses and that they will need to come out of the grant money.

Treasurer's Report:

The board went over the report that had been left by Kay. There was no motion to approve the report.

Harold Polzin made a motion to adjourn, Dennis Thornton made a second. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.
