### **CLERKS REPORT**

The Clerk read the minutes from the December 12, 2022 meeting. There was not an end of the year meeting. Wade made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Alvin, all two in favor none opposed, motion carried. The Clerk asked about additional public places to post the agenda and meeting notices. Wade made a motion to accept posting at Club 22 or Brandl's Cheese factory in addition to the town hall, Recycling Center and the Town Website, seconded by Alvin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

### **AGENDA**

#### **OPERATOR LICENSES**

Operator license request for Jennifer Ghent was gone over. She will be working at Border's Inn and Suites. Wade made a motion to approve as presented, seconded by Alvin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

#### **CHAIMAN'S REPORT**

Alvin went to the DOT meeting yesterday to discuss the preliminary road project that will take place on the east side of highway 22 due to unstable ground around the bridge.

Alvin also said he has talked to Associated Appraisal about having to do a revaluation for the town. There are different ways of doing them, going house to

house and doing a full evaluation by getting inside, (this is the most expensive), or raising the taxes a certain percentage for three years or just drive up to the property and look around. We will need to talk about this at Board of Review and possibly do this in 2024 or 2025.

We will need to do brush spraying this spring. One and a half miles of blacktop is about all we can do this year due to costs. Grants would be a possibility but will need to check into this more.

Alvin talked about the Recycling Center; he stated that possibly fifty houses may have to continue to use this. They may have to pay since we are offering them an option for garbage pickup.

Snowmobile grooming should not be done until after we have enough snow otherwise crops that winter in the field can be destroyed.

### **SUPERVISOR REPORT**

Wade stated that Cloverleaf Lake Rd is very slippery, Dick Hesse said it had been sanded once already.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

Colleen Weishoff Treasurer went over the bills and finances. Wade made a motion to approve the finances, seconded by Alvin all in favor none opposed motion carried.
