CLERKS REPORT

Paul Hahns new fee schedule for permits was gone over, a motion to approve the schedule was made by Wade Wisnefske, seconded by Cory Retzlaff, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Monday March 27th at 7:00 pm will be the audit to go over the books for 2022 to put together the financial report.

Alvin went to the fire meeting on Tuesday and received the bids for the new fire truck . They ranged from \$687,000. To \$799,000. Marion Body Works submitted a bid for \$689,000. Cory Retzlaff made a motion to approve the bid from Marion Body Works, seconded by Wade Wisnefske, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

A Certified Survey Map was gone over for Imago Dei, it consists of three one-acre parcels. The parcels need 100 feet frontage on a town road. These parcels can be sewerred, however the third lot does not meet town ordinance requirements. Cory made a motion to send the map back for corrections so that it does meet

our requirements, after that is completed, we would approve the map. Seconded by Wade, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin stated that the Town's Association had an article on charging our residents for garbage can be done without having to lower our levy limit.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Wade said the hose in the firehouse has been completed.

TREASURER'S REPORT
