SPECTRUM OVERVIEW

Two gentlemen from Spectrum presented to the town what they have been doing in our town. They are installing fiber optics for people around the lakes. It is being paid for by a grant that they have acquired. They should be completed with this by September 30, 2024. They said that if you already have Spectrum nothing will change, cable for those not using Spectrum will be ran to houses at no charge. They offer many services and costs vary by which tier you pick. Another program will be coming soon after this one is completed to add on upgrades. One pod can go out at least 2000 feet.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Colleen went over the bank statements and the bills to be paid. Cody made by motion to accept her report as presented, seconded by Wade all in favor none opposed, motion carried

CLERKS REPORT

The minutes from the April monthly meeting had been sent to the board members. With one correction concerning when oak wilt starts and ends, Wade Wisnefske made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Cody, all in favor non opposed, motion carried.

DISC GOLF

Connie Stuedel talked about the proposal to make a disc golf area across the road from Sandy Beach. She stated that most of the work and the costs will be done

by volunteers. For the ones working, they will need to sign a waiver from the town. Cody and Connie will walk the proposed area and give an update in June. The playground equipment still needs to be removed due to liability for the town.

SCOTT CONSTRUCTION

Chip seal will be done on Spruce to 22 to Evergreen and also Belle Plaine Ave. The costs will be around \$70,000.00. Wade made a motion to approve, seconded by Cody, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried. This will be done around the 4th of July.

Crack Filling

Crack filling will be done on Cloverleaf to Shoenrock towards the Long Lake outlet. Wade made a motion to approve, seconded by Cody, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

COMPOST

We had an inspection at the Compost site, we have until June 2nd to become compliant. We will need to start turning the compost to reduce temperature, we must increase low vegetation around the burn area up to 100 feet. We may need to purchase a disk to do that. Colleen has one for sale, Wade will go and look at it to see if this would work for us. A motion was made by Wade to approve the compost items, seconded by Cody, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

SHORT TERM RENTAL ORDINANCE

This item will be moved to June, so that the board has a chance to go over what was sent to us from our attorney.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin talked about building permits, we have had many, but they are not huge projects.

A zoning meeting will be had in June, Mike Siegel requests a zoning change. He purchased some additional land that was added to his parcel and would like to have this land changed from Commercial to either General Ag or Residential.

SUPERVISOR REPORT

Peter Jensema asked for some screenings to be put by Gibson Island so that it can be placed up to the board walk and in the parking lot. Dick will get 5 or 6 loads over there.

Wade made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Alvin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.
