Alvin gave a report on the County Fair that had been held recently, he said the Fair grossed about \$43,000. The fireman stand had about 50 volunteers helping through out the fair. On Sunday they sold 900 hamburgers. Tips for the volunteers added up to \$1200.00 and the money was given to the Animal Rescue.

Leann Zimdars asked the board if they needed anything additional to fix three of their lots located on Adams Beach to restore the shoreline. They have talked to the DNR and Shawano zoning and was approved by them to do so. Alvin said nothing additional is needed from the town.
