TREASURER'S REPORT

We also discussed putting together a utility ordinance, the Clerk is to contact Rich Carlson to put together a generic ordinance.

Discussion was had on the short-term rental ordinance, we looked at our Room Tax Ordinance to see if we can add some of the suggestions we had talked about before that we thought we should include such as quiet time, parking,

applications through the town plus inspections through the state. Cody will write something up and have it for the next meeting.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin said that a Forester walked Gibson Island with him and Dick Hesse, someone from Wamsco also was present. A lot of wood that has already fallen needs to be cleaned up, he said that on the south side they had to walk single file, if we are going to change the isthmus we may need to change the variance. We will continue to work on this. Alvin also meet with the snowplow crew at the County. It was decided that they need to get the main roads done sooner and be more efficient.
