TREASURER'S REPORT

CLERKS REPORT

The minutes from the July 14'th and the August 2nd Special Meeting had been sent to the board for approval, without any additions or corrections A motion from Wade was made to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Luke, all in favor non opposed, motion carried.

SHAWANO COUNTY SERVICE AGREEMENT

Grant Bystol from Shawano County Highway presented a service agreement to the town which needed to be signed if we are going to use Shawano County for snow plowing this year. He said they need a better handle on which towns will be using them so that they know how many employees and machinery they will need. After discussion Wade made a motion to approve signing the agreement, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

SHAWANO COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Alvin explained this agreement was in case of a disaster, without signing it the town of Belle Plaine would not be eligible for any available funds. Wade made a motion to approve the agreement, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried. This agreement will need to be dropped off at the Shawano Sheriff's office.

Lynn stated that Kara from the County Clerk's office will be retiring soon. She recognized Shanda Hubertus for all the great work she has done for Belle Plaine through WAMSCO.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Alvin said that short term rentals need to follow our ordinance and also meet state regulations.

Alvin mentioned that we now have members for our Zoning Board of Appeals, they are Mark Retzlaff, Nick Hesse, Jeff Polzin, Bobbie Krozell, Kyle Krueger and Kim Dillenburg.

Glen McMahon was appointed to the Gibson Island Stewardship Committee. Forester Tommy Stueck agreed to be an occasional Forester Consultant for Gibson Island.

Luke made a motion to approve the Zoning Committee and Stewardship members, seconded by Alvin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Shanda talked to the board concerning the land that was given to the town located from Cloverleaf Lake Rd to Pine Grove Rd, she would like to start a walking trail on that property with native plants growing along it. It could be used for teaching and gathering seeds. Wamsco will pay for this to be done and do the maintenance it would require. Luke made a motion to approve this project, seconded by Wade, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried. Alvin said a fire number will be needed at this property.
