At 9:30 a.m. On December 3, 2025 Alvin Bartz called to order a special meeting to redo the budget hearing that originally been held on November 10, 2025. This meeting is being redone because of wanting to raise the town levy limit. The original meeting was not approved by the WDR because the actual dollar amount, we wanted to raise the limit was not stated in the original notice. Present for roll call was Wade Wisnefske Supervisor #1, Luke Heling Supervisor #2, Kristine Vomastic Clerk absent Colleen Weishoff Treasurer.

### **5 Citizens Present**

Alvin went over the budget for 2026. He then opened it up for any questions from the floor. There were none. He then closed the budget hearing.

Alvin then went over resolution 11-25 which was signed on October 18, 2025. The purpose for that resolution was to let the electors know that the town was going to have a meeting on November 10, 2025 to raise the levy limit \$100,000.00. Alvin opened up the floor for any questions. William Krewal asked why we had not done a referendum to have the town vote on the levy increase. Alvin stated towns under 3000 did not have to do it with a referendum they could have a special meeting and let the electors vote at that time. Bobbi Chapin asked how much would this raise property taxes. Alvin said he guessed less than \$100.00 per household. The electors then voted yes or no to raise the levy. The ballots were picked up and counted. The results were 8 yes and 1 no. Glenn McMann made a motion to close the special meeting, seconded by Dick Hesse.

Another special meeting was then held to approve the local levy and the highway expenditures (which includes possibly a new truck). Glen McMann made a motion to approve both, seconded by Dick Hesse, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Bobbi Chapin made a motion to adjourn this special meeting, seconded by Sally Ottis, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Alvin then called to order a town board meeting to approve the 2026 budget that includes the levy limit. Wade made a motion to approve the budget, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

The board then went over the levy limits for the public schools and the universities. Wade made a motion to approve them, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed motion carried.

Operator license for Maxwell Lopinski was gone over, Wade made a motion to approve the license, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

Wade made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.
