### **TREASURER AND CLERK WAGES**

Since the Recycling Center is officially closed garbage/recycling containers will be picked up by Harters, they will also be buying the compactor from us. Luke made a motion to accept the offer to buy the compactor, seconded by Alvin, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.
