AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 33-94
RELATING TO CONTROL OF OAK WILT FUNGUS

The town of Belle Plaine wishes to amend the Oak Wilt Ordinance changing the time frame for not being able to trim, cut or prune oak trees. We will be changing the time frame in Section 3 to the following below, the rest of the ordinance will stay the same with a new effective date below for the new SECTION 3:

SECTION 3- PROHIBITIONS OF TRIMMING, CUTTING OR PRUNING OAK TREES FROM APRIL 1 TO AUGUST 15TH OF EACH YEAR.

No person shall trim, cut or prune any oak trees in the Town of Belle Plaine between April 1 to August 15 of each year without obtaining a written permit from the Town Clerk, except a person may girdle and /or trench an infected tree to prevent the spread of the disease.

SECTION 11-EFFECTIVE DATE FOR AMENDING SECTION 3.


Section 3 of this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
