#### **AGENDA:**

Lynn Tober Shawano County board member gave an update from some of the recent meetings she has attended; she attended orientation with new board members and there will be reassessing of committees soon. There was a unanimous vote to proceed with the new jail and courthouse.

#### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

Colleen went over the March bank statements and the bills to be paid. She also mentioned that Spectrum has increased its monthly amount. Wade made a motion to accept her report as presented, seconded by Luke, all in favor none opposed, motion carried.

#### **CLERKS REPORT**

The minutes from the March monthly meeting had been sent to the board members. With no corrections or additions Luke made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Wade, all in favor non opposed, motion carried.

#### **AGENDA:**

#### **ATV and UTV Ordinance**

Shawano County is hoping everyone will accept Shawano Counties ATV and UTV ordinance, they have updated things to include items that had not been thought of at the beginning of passing their ordinance. The Wade made a motion to approve amending the towns ordinance to be replaced with the Counties ordinance, seconded by Luke, all in favor none opposed, motion carried.

## **CSM MAP**

Club 22 land wants to be parceled into two pieces. The septic is 250 feet from the well. It would also have to be rezoned; it is now commercial. Luke said it may not be buildable and should have to meet certain conditions. Alvin mentioned that this would affect him because his field is located right next to the parcel and would have to stay back a certain amount of feet when planting etc. Luke asked if this condition would hold true for everyone? Wade made a motion to approve splitting however a home would be a conditional use. Luke seconded, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

## **SCOTT CONSTRUCTION**

Alvin presented a quote from Scott Construction; it is cheaper than last year. We will agree for one mile for now so that we can lock in the price. Luke made a motion to approve the price, seconded by Wade, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

## **Mickster's Grill**

Wade made a motion to approve the regular liquor license for Mickster's Grill starting on May 18<sup>th</sup> 2026, seconded by Luke, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

## **NEW RECYCLING GRANT**

A new Recycling Grant is required by the Wisconsin DNR. The Clerk presented the new ordinance that she put together from our present ordinance and what new information that is required. Luke made a motion to approve the ordinance, seconded by Wade, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

## **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT**

Alvin gave a report on the zoning maps he has been working on; we decided the way it is being proposed is not good, it's too cluttered, he will go back to the courthouse again.

This week the Compost site will be open on Wednesday from 9-3. Because of all the clean up that needs to be done because of the ice storm.

Alvin stated that three trees on the corner by Friendship Cemetery will need to be taken care of they are very rotten and could cause a lot of damage. Alvin will see what the County would charge us to have them taken down. They will look at them on their drive to check the roads.

Wade said there is a complaint concerning the culverts on Rustic drive, they will look at them when they check the roads.
